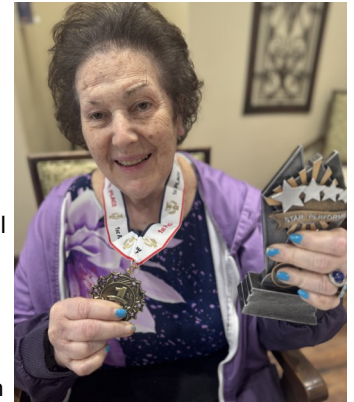
Last month, we proudly hosted our 3rd Annual Cornhole Tournament at Aravilla Clearwater! A special congrats to our champions of this month's tournament:
