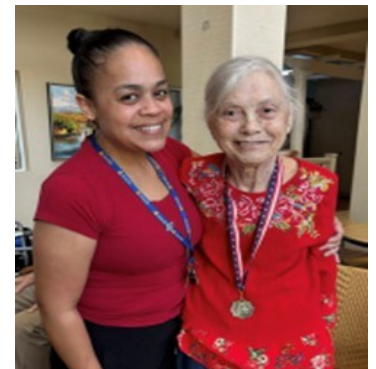

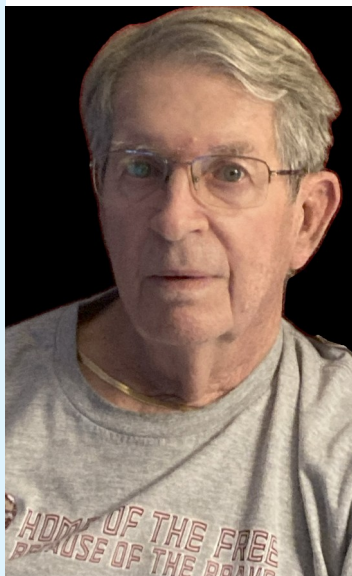

Thomas R.

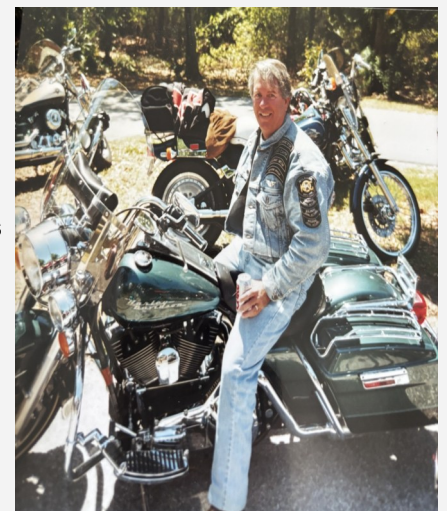
We are delighted to celebrate Thomas R. as a cherished member of our Aravilla family!
